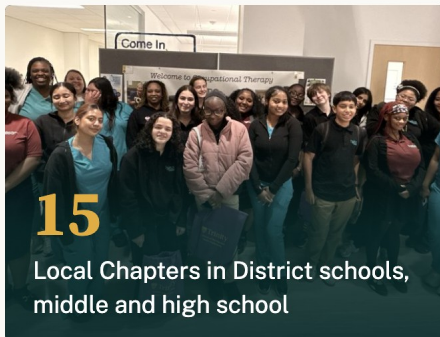




The District's next health workforce is already enrolled.

WHO WE ARE

DC HOSA is the District of Columbia's chartered association of HOSA – Future Health Professionals, a career and technical student organization serving students preparing for nursing, medicine, emergency response, public health, behavioral health, and allied health careers.

Chapters sit inside District public, public charter, and independent schools. The association is run by an elected student officer team and supported by chapter advisors, some of whom teach health science courses full time.

WHAT MEMBERSHIP LOOKS LIKE

Members compete in skill-based events judged by working clinicians & professionals, from emergency medical response to medical terminology to public health advocacy. They complete service hours that count toward the District's graduation service requirement.

They also train outside the classroom. Current partners include Children's National Hospital, the Occupational Therapy Simulation Lab at Trinity Washington University, Safe Kids Worldwide, and So Kids SOAR along with our GW EMT Training Program, UDCC School of Nursing, Catholic University Conway School of Nursing, and the OSSE Advanced Technical Centers.
